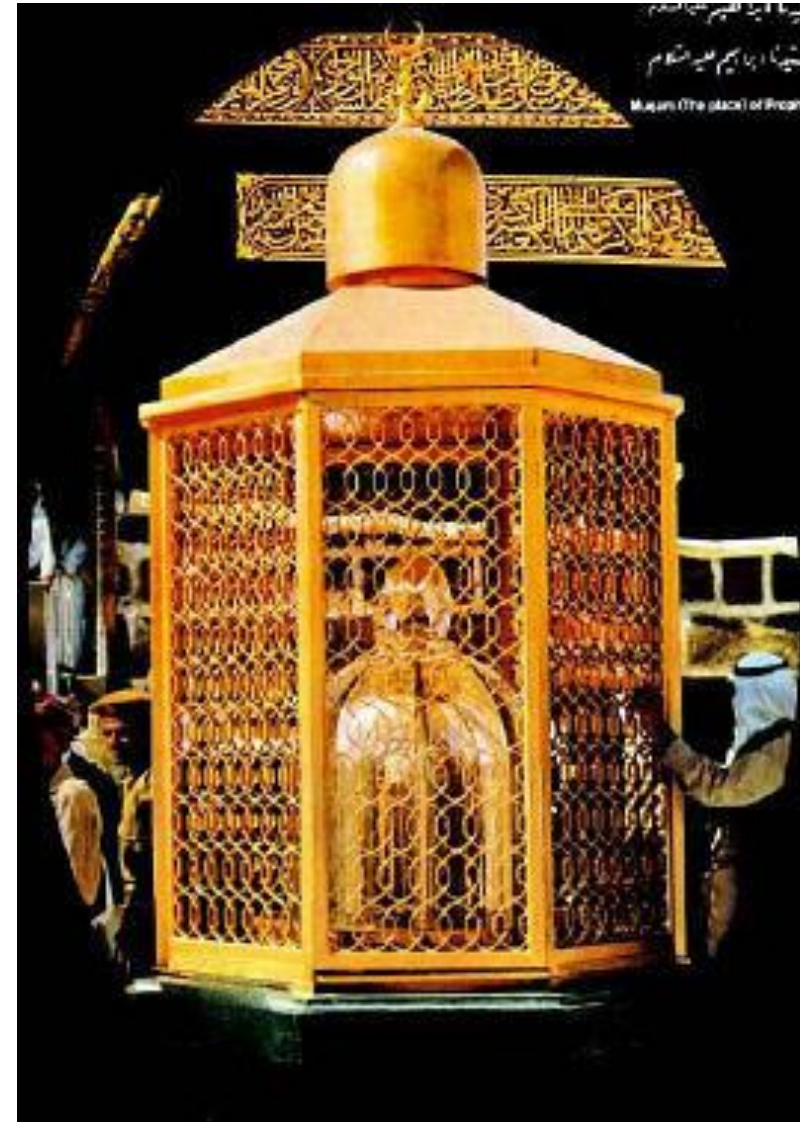

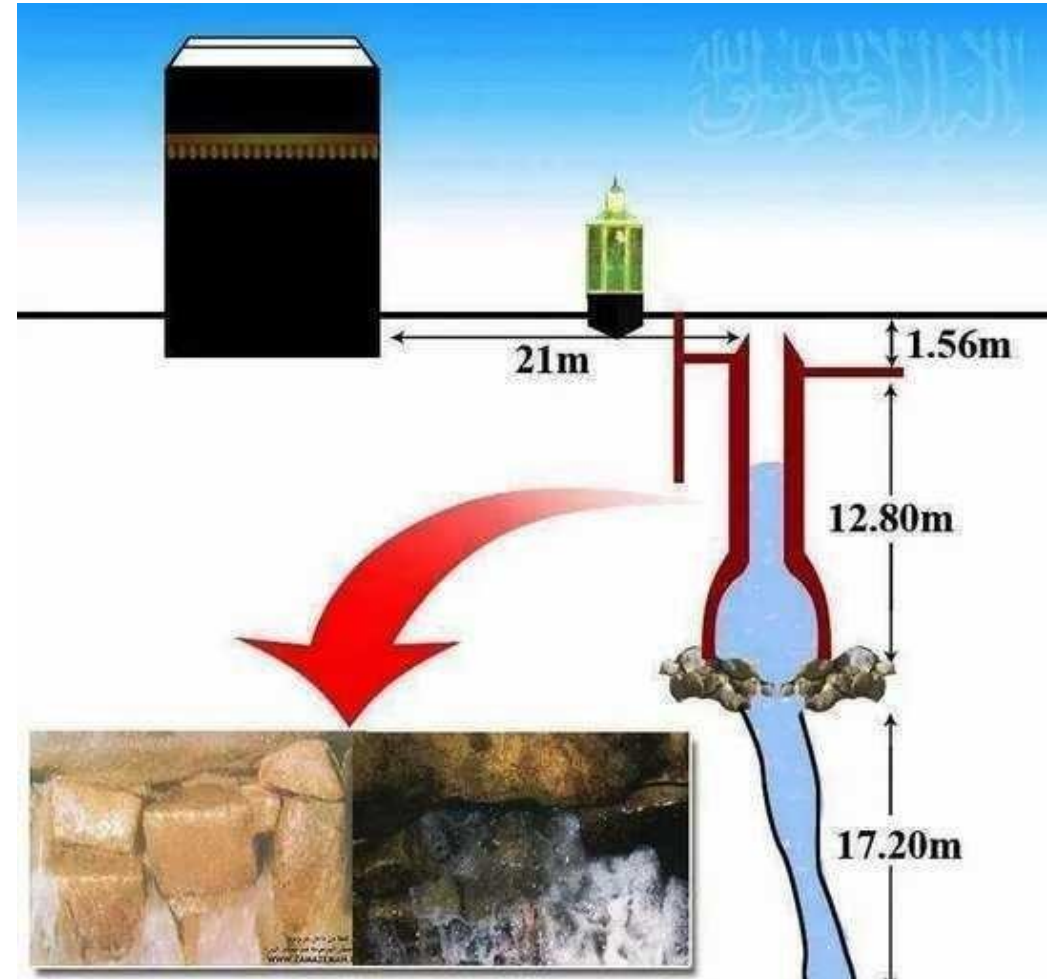

The Sacrifice of the Prophet(s) in the Hajj

فَمَنْ تَمَنَّعَ بِالْعُمْرَةِ إِلَى الْحَجِّ فَمَا اسْتَيْسَرَ مِنَ الْهَدْيِ

1. The Prophet(s) sacrificed 63 camels on the Hajj.
2. Ali[®] sacrificed for the Prophet(s) another 37 to make it 100.
3. The Prophet(s) did the Qiran Hajj as he had his sacrifice with him. Otherwise he would have done Tamatuu.
4. For the one performing the Tamatuu or Qiran Hajj the sacrifice is obligatory. For the one performing the Ifraad it's optional.

Jabal Rahmah

- 1.The Prophet(s) gave his final sermon at the foot of the mountain
- 2.Also known as Jabal Arafah
- 3.Not Sunnah to climb the mountain.



Mash'air Al-Haram

فَإِذَا أَفْضَيْتُمْ مِّنْ عَرَفَاتٍ فَاذْكُرُوا اللَّهَ عِندَ الْمَشْعَرِ الْحَرَامِ

1. Mash'air Al-Haram is another name for Muzdalifah according to the majority of the scholars of Tafseer.
2. There is no need to go to the hill called Mash'air Al-Haram.

“I have stood here and all of `Arafat is a place for standing and avoid standing at Batn `Uranah.”



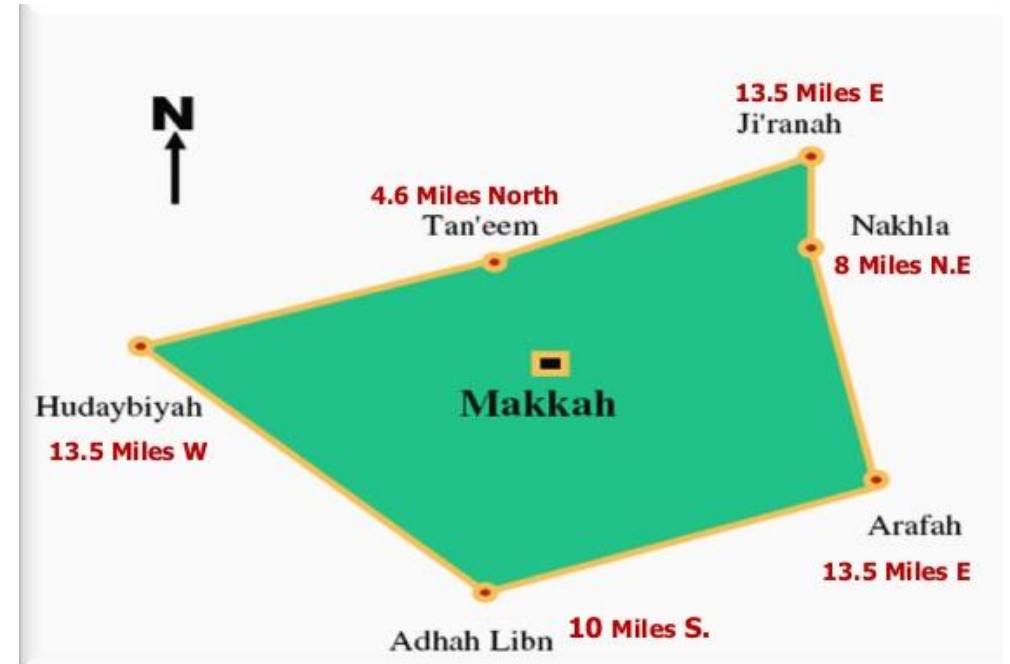
Wadi Muhassir
